STANDING ORDER FOR AUDIO-VIDEO CONFERENCES

The Court has implemented technology to conduct pretrial and status conferences in civil and criminal matters where all parties are represented by counsel through the use of simultaneous audiovisual transmission. Participation in audio-video conferences can be scheduled on an available date and time confirmed in writing with the court's staff by fax to (985)446-6423, email to divisionb@17thjdc.com, or by scheduling an available date and time contained in the court's on-line calendar for Division B, which may be accessed on the website, 17thjdc.online.


An Attorney may attend pre-trial and status conferences by audio-video appearance provided the attorney complies with the following orders, to wit:

IT IS ORDERED that the attorney wishing to attend by audio-video conference shall transmit a letter to the chambers of Division B via fax to (985)446-6423 or email divisionb@17thjdc.com, containing the name and number of the case, the date of the conference, and the name, telephone number, and email addresses of who will be attending the conference.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the presence of anyone other than counsel during the audio-video conference without the consent of the Court, or any recording of the audio-video conference, may be considered contempt of court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that proper attire is required for video conference participation.
